Between 5-9 November entry was gained to a non dwelling property at Escott near Williton and an amount of alcohol stolen.

Monksilver residents have informed me that there have been suspicious activity around the village and surrounding hamlets.

Please make sure that you have checked your windows and doors of your home and any outbuildings.

During this season prior to Christmas, thefts are at a peak, so please be aware of anything unusual.
